St. Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 11:27-29, “Anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the Body (and Blood) eats and drinks judgment on himself.”

Therefore, prompted by love and born of heartfelt conviction, on the basis of Scripture alone, we must follow Christ’s command. It would not be loving to allow spiritual harm to come to someone who is not fully aware of the teachings of the Bible in regard to the “real presence of Christ’s Body and Blood.

So we lovingly and respectfully ask guests and visitors, who do not hold membership in a congregation of the LCMS, to visit with the Pastor before or after the worship hour regarding their desire to receive Holy Communion.
